

CAMPER RELEASE POLICY

In accordance with the Health Services requirements set forth by the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention under the Department of Health and Human Services, "Rules relating to youth camps, primitive, and trip camping" (10-144 CMR 208 section 8.A.2.), Camp NOMACCA has set forth the following policy regarding camper release.

Campers who are required to leave the camp ground for any reason other than participation in camp sponsored activities shall only be released from camp into the custody of a designated person, previously identified in writing, who may be the camper's parent, guardian, or other person(s) identified by the parent or guardian.

The identification of such persons may be fulfilled upon completion of the "Camper Check-Out" portion of the "Camp NOMACCA Camper Registration Form" by the camper's parent or guardian. This form will be available upon request or at the camp's website www.nomacca.com.
